The McKinney-Vento Act provisions requiring immediate enrollment are even more important in a case of child abduction. If there is legitimate cause for concern, the school should immediately contact the police, DCF, or if possible, the student's parents, consistent with state law. While law enforcement and DCF conduct their investigations, the safest place for the student is school, rather than isolated with a potential abductor.
